

Choosing Baptism

Today we read Acts 8:26-40. Below are some questions we used to guide our discussions.

1. Describe a time when you read or learned about something that made you really excited.
2. How did Philip know where to go?
3. Verse 35 says, "Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus." What is the good news?
4. After hearing Philip explain the Scriptures what did the man immediately want to do? Why?
5. People don't usually get baptized when they hear the good news about Jesus for the first time. Why should they wait? What are some things they should be sure of? **People should be sure that they really believe the good news. Sometimes people can change their mind. Also, it is important for people to talk with their leaders before they get baptized. Leaders can confirm that God has worked in the person and has given them saving faith in Jesus.**
